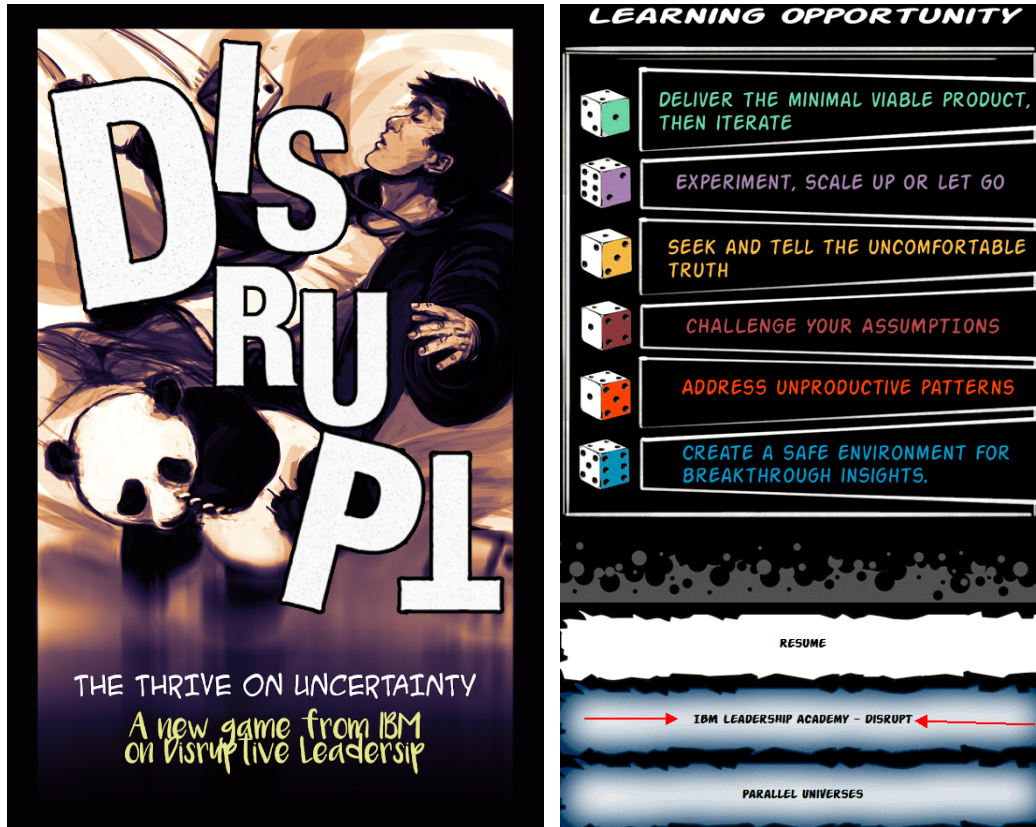
Man of Honor - Published on Steam

Man of Honor is a mafia and film noir themed top-down shooter video game. Players navigate an area and, depending on the objective of the level, find and steal a set of specified items, place bombs on and blow up a set of objects, or assassinate a specific target. While trying to accomplish these objectives, the player will have to fight off gangsters with an arsenal of weapons that increases as the game continues. The player can also utilize other strategies like using an enemy's corpse as a shield and briefly slowing down time (by taunting enemies) to help complete the objectives and avoid being killed. Once the first shot is fired in a level (either by the player or an enemy), a police timer will start. When the timer reaches 0, cops will appear in that level to attack the player.



Seasons of the Sorcerer - Available Soon

An action adventure game, inspired by and set to Vivaldi's *Four Seasons*, set in renaissance Italy about a sorcerer on a quest to find and rescue his master from an unknown danger. This game is currently in development and we hope to release it in 2019.



Disrupt

- A Comic Book Adventure Game

A comic book-like adventure game with a dynamic storytelling style to train 300 top IBM leaders in 160 countries around the world in disruptive leadership. Through interactivity with the player, the story evolves in different ways. The game consists of comic book panels/pages, with a user interface that allows players to navigate the game, save progress, etc. A server side administrative tool was created to allow administrators to modify the story by changing (modifying, adding, deleting) the action buttons as well as the pages of the story. User progress are saved on a server.



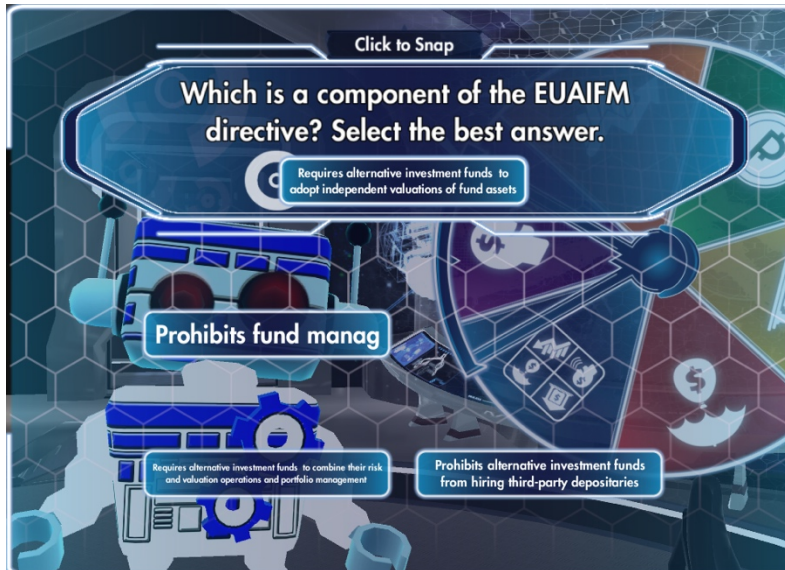
Learning is an Adventure - Developed for IBM

An Adventure Game that delivers strategic training to IBMers. A sidescrolling corporate training game where the player explores an office building to find videos that educate them on various subjects. In this game scenario an IBM consultant is given the task of creating a presentation for a client on the topic of Social Business (but the game needs to be flexible enough so that we could use training content on any subject). He is given 4 objectives to accomplish, 4 subject matter experts (game characters) to interview and 4 Links to training materials. Each time the player accomplishes each task, he is given 10 BluePoints. Those points are redeemable at the IBM Rewards Catalog once the Adventure Game is completed. At the end of the adventure he will have completed a short PPT deck incorporating the 4 objectives and will give a recorded video client presentation of the deck. This video will be available for review by the consultant's manager.



Learn & Earn - Developed for IBM

A corporate training game about software developers exploring a medieval fantasy world. They must travel through different realms and defeat monsters by answering questions about their work in order to return home.



Learnapalooza

This is a game similar to DuoLingo or the Great Brain Experiment where Learning is embedded in a fun game using game elements like Points, Levels and Leaderboards. When each skill level is achieved, the user would be given Palooza coins which could then be used to purchase fun puzzle games in the Palooza Store. This would also have to be flexible for the types of content that could be entered into the game.

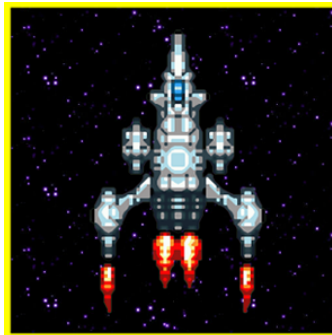
Climate! - Published on the Windows Store

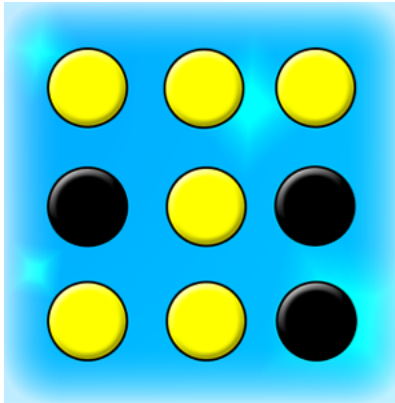

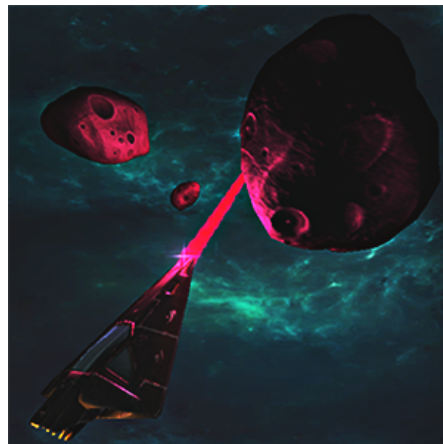

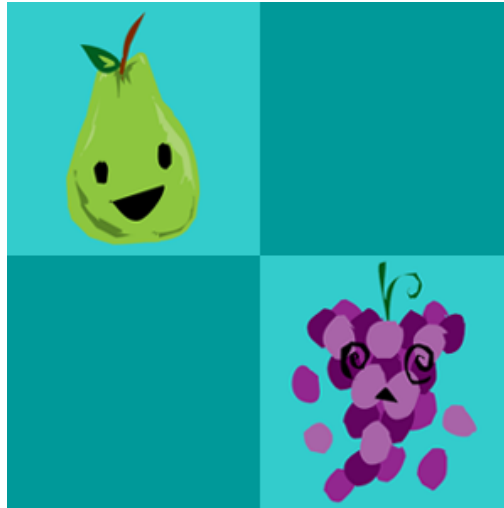

The system of Japanese numerals is the system of number names used in the Japanese language. The Japanese numerals in writing are entirely based on the Chinese numerals and the grouping of large numbers follow the Chinese tradition of grouping by 10,000. This brain game uses Japanese kanji numbers 1 through 8 to exercise your memory. Did you know that the Japanese use separate systems for counting for oneself and for displaying numbers to others, which both proceed up to 10? For counting, one begins with the palm open, then counts up to 5 by curling up (folding down) the fingers, starting from the thumb – thus one has just the thumb down (and others extended), while 4 has only the pinkie extended, and 5 has a fist. One then counts up to 10 by proceeding in the reverse order, extending the fingers, starting at the pinkie – thus 6 is the same as 4, 7 the same as 3, and so forth, with 10 ending with the palm open. While this introduces ambiguity, it is not used to present to others, so this is generally not a problem. When displaying for others, one starts with the hand closed, and extends fingers, starting with the index, going to the pinkie, then ending with the thumb, as in the United States. For numbers above 5, one uses an open hand (indicating 5) and places the appropriate number of fingers from the other hand against the palm (palms facing each other) – so 6 has the index finger against the palm, and so forth. To display 10, one presents both hands open and palm outwards.

We are Simbryo. We make games.

Five months ago, in partnership with Microsoft, we set a goal for ourselves: publish 100 games on two platforms, Windows 8 and Windows Phone, in 5 months. Everyone else called this venture "Project Impossible," but we called it "Project Centurion." The title, "Centurion," was used by the Roman army to designate an officer who was in charge of 100 men. The term also pays tribute to the legendary 100 Roman soldiers who fought for their lives behind enemy lines after their legion was decimated in a devastating guerrilla attack in about 100 BCE. We created a cool logo for the project, which was inspired by the Chinese numeral 100. If you rotate the Chinese numeral 90 degrees counter-clockwise, it looks like the Hindu-Arabic-English numeral 100.

Making 100 games in 5 months required that we make 20 games every month - that's 5 games a week. Assuming we worked a 5-day workweek, that meant we had to publish a game every day. We learned a lot along the way: we enhanced our skills and learned from our mistakes. We built a great team of developers who were creative despite challenging circumstances, including no heat, limited electricity and a leaky roof.

This game is our grand finale. It's a matching game that includes cards for our 100 games. Each time you play, you'll see a sample of our game cards. We hope you enjoy this tribute to our hard work and our "against all odds" attitude. We hope that Project Centurion serves as an inspiration to other indie game developers
